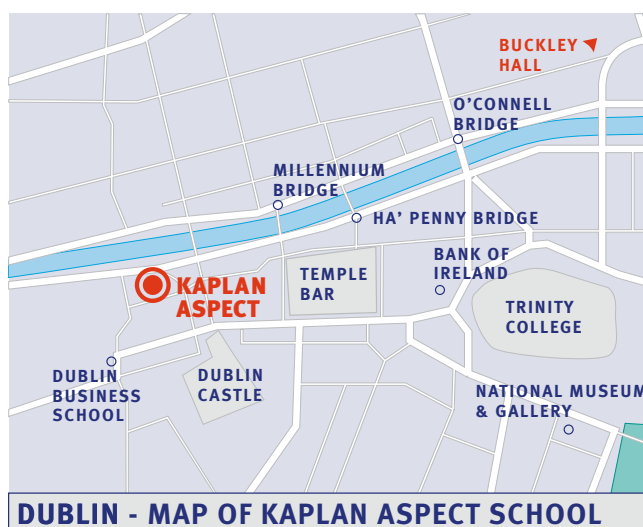


Student Residence Dublin

Buckley Hall

Buckley Hall Residence is a state-of-the-art residence located in the heart of the city, only 7 minutes by foot from the centre of Dublin, and 17 minutes' walk or a short tram ride from the Kaplan Aspect school. Buckley Hall enjoys excellent transportation links. The main railway station, Connolly station, and the LUAS tram line are a 4-minute walk away, while the main bus station is only one stop by tram.

The area is lively and there are many pubs, shops, a call/fax and internet facility and restaurants on the main road, all within a minute's walk from the residence. Buckley Hall accommodates approximately 130 students in total, and is split into several apartments, each containing one single and one twin room. There is a shared, open-plan kitchen-living room and dining area in each apartment. A warden lives on the premises and there is a security presence throughout the night.

Accommodation details

Type of accommodation

Self-catering student apartments, each consisting of communal kitchen/lounge, 1 single and 1 twin bedroom.

Meals

Self-catering. The modern shared kitchen is fully equipped so students can prepare their own meals.

Kitchen

The kitchen is shared and fitted to a high standard with cooker, a large refrigerator, microwave, kettle and toaster.

Rooms

Each bright and spacious study bedroom consists of a sink, bed, bedside table, desk, chair and wardrobe.

Bathrooms

Each apartment has 2 bathrooms, one of which is en-suite for the twin room.

Utilities

Adequate electricity, gas and water are included in the accommodation fee. Students are liable to pay for excessive use of utilities. Electrical current is 240 volts AC (50 cycles). Students are advised to bring a transformer and plug adaptor from their country.

Internet and phone

There are no telephone facilities in the apartments. A private call facility is available one minute's walk from the residence. Free wireless internet access is available in the apartments.

Laundry

The token-operated washers and dryers are located in the basement of the building. Both wash tokens and drying tokens cost EUR 3 each.

Security and keys

Keys and security pads will be given to students on arrival.

Bed linen and towels

One set of bed linen is provided but students must bring their own towels. Students are responsible for washing bed linen themselves.

Deposit

Students need to provide €200 cash to the residential warden as a deposit on arrival. The deposit will be refunded upon satisfactory inspection of the student's room following departure.

Breakages and damage

Students are liable for any breakages and damage in the apartment. Costs of any damages, including loss of apartment keys, are the responsibility of the student and agreement of payment is to be made with the school.

Visitors

No unaccompanied visitors are allowed into the residences. Visitors are to leave by 11pm. No visitors are permitted to stay overnight.

Noise and restrictions

Students are requested to be considerate to their neighbours and keep noise levels to a minimum, especially after 10pm.

Arrival and departure

Students may arrive on either Saturday or Sunday and must do so between the hours of 14.00 and 22.30. All students must depart by 10am on the day of departure.

Availability

Buckley Hall Residence is available for July and August 2009 to students aged 18 and over.
