## Student Progress

The individual progress of each English for High School student is carefully monitored and assessed on a regular basis. School progress reports are sent to the students' guardians halfway through the course. The reports provide detailed information on the progress of the student in each language skill, their behaviour and attendance record.

Students must achieve the equivalent of 5.5 IELTS in each of the four skills in order to graduate from the programme and commence high school. Language skills are also assessed according to the ESL scales.

## Partner High Schools

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be eligible for direct entry into one of our partner high schools. Students can choose from either Stella Maris College or St Augustine's College, both located in Sydney's Northern Beaches district.

## Student Welfare and Accommodation

### Travel and medical insurance

### Under 18 years of age supervision

A qualified Student Supervisor will be nominated to all students on the English for High School programme for the duration of their studies at Kaplan International Colleges and at their chosen High School.

### Carefully chosen homestays

Our homestay hosts are carefully selected and regularly visited by our accommodation officers. They are chosen for the good standard of their homes and for the friendly and caring welcome they extend to young guests who will be treated as members of the family during their stay. Homestay hosts will welcome student guests on arrival. Hosts are usually located either within walking distance or a short bus ride to school.

### Meeting and transfer service

For added peace of mind, Kaplan can arrange a return transfer service to and from selected airports and your study destination. The transfer includes a meeting service at the airport. Meeting and transfer services must be arranged in advance and ensure students are in safe hands from the minute they arrive abroad.

### First day induction

On the first morning at school, students will receive a comprehensive induction to help them settle in as quickly as possible. The induction includes a welcome talk by the course director; a placement test to determine level of English; information about classes, timetable, the school and area; an overview of school activities and excursions; and a tour of the school and facilities. Students will also be given an identity card, for which they need to bring a passport-sized photograph. The card contains personal details as well as important contact information if a student needs assistance.

### Dedicated and trained welfare staff

At our Sydney Manly school, we have a dedicated welfare officer whose responsibility is to ensure that students are healthy and happy while staying with Kaplan. All of our staff are happy to help with any issues that students may have. In addition, in case of any medical matters arising, we have staff members trained in First Aid, and a first aid kit on site, as well as close links with local doctors, dentists and hospitals.
