## Southampton Row

Southampton Row apartments are ideally located in the central and fashionable district of Bloomsbury, a short walk from the British Museum and the Covent Garden school. The apartment's location also benefits from excellent transport links, so students are well placed to enjoy all that London has to offer.

Kaplan students have the opportunity to stay in one of the apartments that offers one single and two twin rooms with a combination of en-suite and shared bathroom facilities. There is also a spacious lounge and shared kitchen. All rooms are well-equipped and decorated to a high standard.

Student residents enjoy wireless internet access, a video entry phone for added security, an elevator, telephone lines for incoming calls, plus a weekly cleaning service and linen change.

### Accommodation details

#### Type of accommodation

Southampton Row apartments are self-catering apartments in the Bloomsbury area of central London. Kaplan students have access to an apartment of one single and two twin rooms. All rooms are furnished with a single bed (two in twin rooms) and wardrobe.

#### Kitchen

The apartment has a fully-fitted and well-equipped kitchen shared between all occupants. The kitchen includes all standard appliances as well as a microwave, crockery, cutlery and utensils.

#### Rooms

Each room has internet access and a telephone line for incoming calls, as well as the furniture mentioned above.

#### Bathrooms

The single room has an en-suite shower and sink. The two twin rooms share two bathrooms, both with bath, shower, sink and WC.

#### Utilities

Electricity, gas and water are included in the accommodation fee. Electrical current is 240 volts AC (50 cycles) and students from some countries may require a transformer and a plug adaptor.

#### Communal facilities

In addition to the shared kitchen and bathroom facilities, there is a spacious lounge and dining area. This includes a dining table and chairs, comfortable sofas, colour television and coffee table.

#### Internet and phone

Broadband internet is available on arrival for an additional charge (estimated to be £20 per month and subject to a maximum bandwidth allowance). A phone service is also available, which enables you to receive incoming calls and make outgoing calls on your own private landline. This service costs an estimated £20 per month based on incoming calls only (outgoing calls are subject to additional charges).

#### Laundry

There is a washer/dryer in the kitchen for students' use. Washing/powder detergent are not provided and students need to purchase this themselves. The communal areas are cleaned once a week, but students are responsible for keeping their bedrooms clean and tidy.

#### Security

There is a video entry phone system for added security.

#### Linen

Bed linen is provided at no extra charge and is changed weekly. Students must provide their own towels.

#### Deposit

A £200 damage deposit is payable on arrival at the residence. This is refundable provided that students leave their room and communal areas in a clean and presentable condition. Costs related to any extra cleaning or the replacement or lost or damaged items will be deducted from the deposit.

#### Bookings

Minimum 6-week booking.

#### Arrival and departure

Arrival must be on a Saturday no earlier than 2pm. Arrival details must be provided to Kaplan in advance. Departure must be on a Saturday by 10am.
