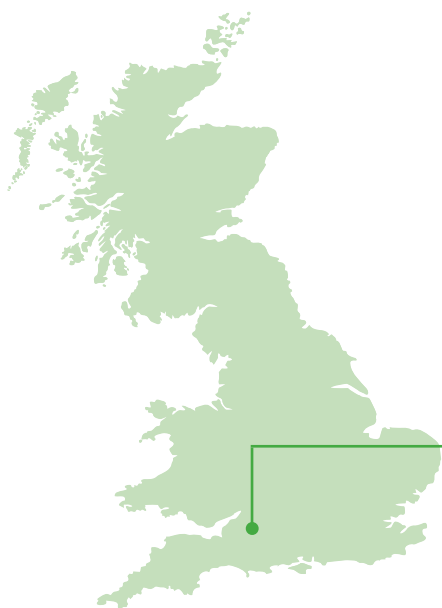

SECURITY

PASSPORTS

Passports are checked on the first day, then stored in a lockable drawer at the homestay.

CURFEW

Students aged 12–13 years: 09:30pm (must be supervised at all times)
