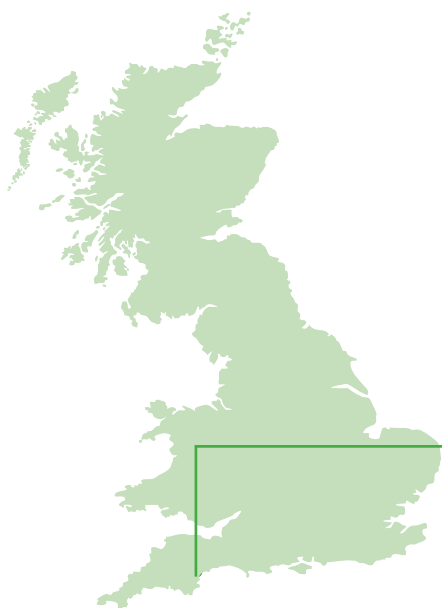

SECURITY

PASSPORTS

Passports are checked on the first day, then stored in a lockable drawer at the homestay.

CURFEW

Students aged 12–13 years: 09:30pm (must be supervised at all times)

14 - 17 year olds: 10:30pm

CAN STUDENTS VISIT THE CITY DURING THE DAY?

Students aged 15+ can visit the city during their lunch break or free time; they must be accompanied by two other students and inform a member of staff.
